## TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Venue is reachable from the main airports close to Milano : Malpensa and Linate.  
Malpensa Airport is the closest to Gazzada-Schianno train station.

### ✚ FROM MALPENSA AIRPORT (RECOMMENDED):

#### 1. MALPENSA AIRPORT- GALLARATE TRAIN STATION

##### - From Terminal 1: **BY TRAIN**

- Take the train to Gallarate train station.

➤ **Duration** of the trip: 25 minutes

➤ **Cost** of a ticket is 2,90 Euros

##### - From Terminal 1 and Terminal 2: **BY BUS**

- take the AirPullman SACO to Gallarate train Station

➤ **Duration:** 25 minutes

➤ **Cost:** Terminal 1 €1.80/ Terminal 2 – €1.60, Tickets can be bought on the bus

#### 2. GALLARATE TRAIN STATION- GAZZADA-SCHIANNO- MORAZZONE: BY TRAIN

- Take a train to Gazzada-Schianno-Morazzone ( there're trains every 30 minutes)

➤ **Duration** of the trip: 20 minutes

➤ **Cost** of a ticket is 2,20 Euros

3. VILLA CAGNOLA IS ABOUT 300 METERS AWAY FROM GAZZADA-SCHIANNO TRAIN STATION.

**✚ FROM LINATE AIRPORT:**

**1. LINATE AIRPORT – FORLANINI – CORSICA TRAIN STATION: BY BUS**

- Take bus 73 direction Milan/Duomo, Stop Milano Forlanini FS - Corsica Station

➤ **Duration** of the trip :14 minutes

➤ **Cost** of a ticket is 1,50 Euros

**- LINATE AIRPORT – FORLANINI – CORSICA TRAIN STATION: BY TAXI**

➤ **Duration** of the trip :5 minutes

➤ **Cost:** ca 12 Euros

**2. MILANO FORLANINI TRAIN STATION TO GAZZADA-SCHIANNO-MORAZZONE**

- Take a train (S5) from Milano Forlanini to Gazzada-Schianno-Morazzone

➤ **Duration** of the trip: ca. 1h20

➤ **Cost** of a ticket is 5,50 Euros

## EXCURSION

### HERMITAGE SANTA CATERINA DEL SASSO, BORROMEAN ISLANDS, ARONA

24th September 2018 - h. 2 p.m

We will leave Villa Cagnola by coach at 2:00 pm to reach the [HERMITAGE OF SANTA CATERINA DEL SASSO](#), a charming balcony over Maggiore Lake.



The project leading to this application has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie grant agreement No 675527



Clinging to a rock face directly overhanging the lake, the hermitage of Santa Caterina del Sasso is certainly one of the most charming sights of [Maggiore Lake](#). Art and history are perfectly integrated in a very striking, natural environment. The entrance to the church is through a portico consisting of four round, renaissance-style arches. The structure of the current building is



truly unique, the fusion of three chapels, originally built separately in three different eras. There are numerous pictorial cycles both inside and outside the Church, mainly covering the period running between the 14th and the 19th century. Art and history merge wonderfully in this most striking of natural frames, almost a balcony leaning out towards the Borromeo Gulf, Stresa and the islands.



After visiting Santa Caterina del Sasso, we'll go on a tour by boat of the [BORROMEAN ISLANDS](#).

The three small [islands](#) are situated in the Italian part of [Lago Maggiore](#), the most westerly of the great Italian subalpine lakes:



[ISOLA BELLA](#), named for [Isabella](#), countess [Borromeo](#), was originally a largely barren rock; after the first improvements and buildings, it was opened by count Carlo III between 1629 and 1652. His son, Vitaliano the 6th, built an attractive summer palace.

[The visit to the Palace and the beautiful garden is optional and the cost per person is 13€.](#)

- [ISOLA MADRE](#), the largest of the three, is also noted for its gardens, which have been maintained since about 1823 in an English style. Its palace, though uninhabited, is splendidly furnished with 16th- to 19th-century Italian masterpieces and paintings.

- [ISOLA DEI PESCATORI](#) or Isola Superiore is now the only inhabited island in the archipelago. It has a fishing village, which in 1971 had a population of 208.

We'll reach [ARONA](#) by boat, where we will have the dinner.

We'll come back by coach to Villa Cagnola in the evening.
